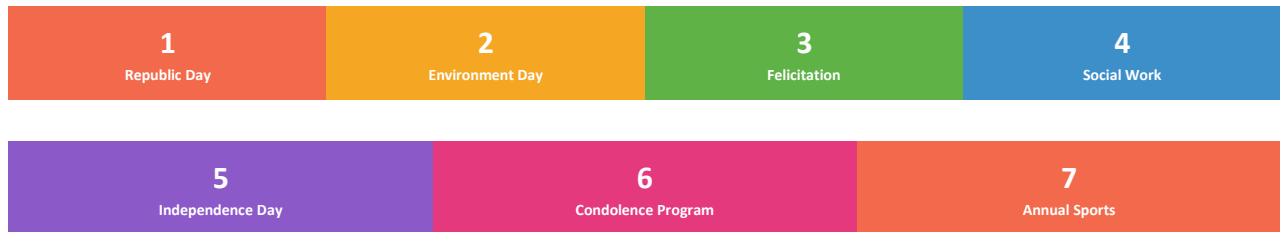


OVERVIEW
